Live-streaming allows your family, friends and others who are unable to attend the service or ceremony to participate from the comfort and convenience of their own home, or anywhere with a mobile device.

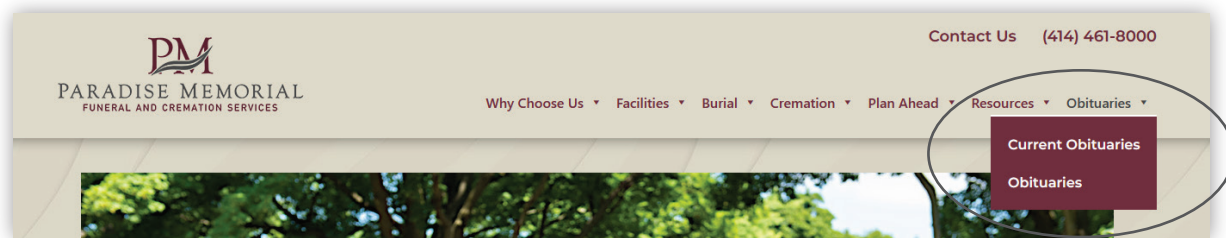
Your family has total control over who can view your service, whether the service is public or private for family only.

For families who wish to have closed services, the live-stream link can be sent directly to friends and family via email.

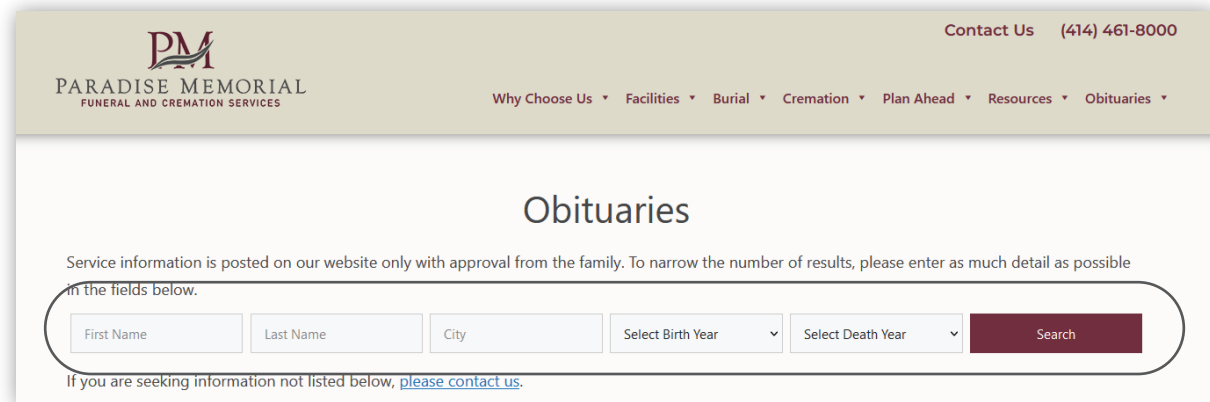
For public services, anyone can participate in the live-stream via our state of the art website.

2. Locate the **"Obituaries"** Navigation Tab and click **"Obituaries"**



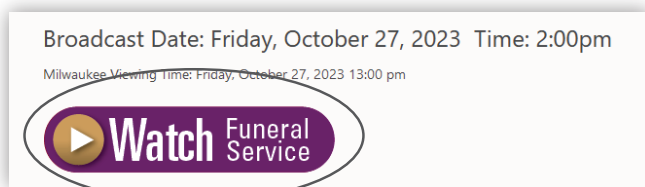
3. Locate the loved one by using the Obituary Search Bar
